# APPROVING RECORDER'S REQUEST TO USE MONIES FROM THE RECORDER'S RECORDS PERPETUATION FUND TO PAY THE RECORDER'S OFFICE SUPPLIES, AND OTHER SERVICES AND CHARGES

- 5. The County Recorder specifically requests that all or a specific, identifiable portion of the Recorder's Records Perpetuation Fund (1189) be used to pay Office Supplies and Other Services and Charges in the amount of \$4,098;
